

# I AM A LEADER AT HOME!

Today in our buddy activity, we talked about the paradigm “**Everyone Can Be a Leader.**” One of the best ways to help your child realize his or her worth and leadership potential is to provide an opportunity to lead. At Line Creek, we offer student leadership roles as a way to teach RESPONSIBILITY, LEADERSHIP, and CONTRIBUTION.

Leadership roles can be used at home.

To begin:

1. Talk with your child about the leadership role he or she might be interested in at home.
2. Discuss why he or she is interested in the role. Ask what leadership qualities your child has that will help. Ask how he or she will handle homework or other commitments with this new-role responsibility.
3. Give your child a week or so to adjust and then discuss how it is going. This may open a conversation on how to handle things that are too easy or too difficult.
